ORDER:

The Andhra Pradesh Municipal and Panchayat workers Federation, Guntur and the Andhra Pradesh Municipal employees Federation (CITU) have demanded to issue orders for appointment of Badili Workers in place of leave vacancies, promotions, death of retired employees to maintain sanitation and also to delete the condition for appointment only in respect of death if harness retirement on medical invalidation vacancies.

2. The Government after careful consideration of the demand have decided that it is not possible to appoint the Badili workers in the above vacancies because of the general policy of Government. But keeping in view the need for improvement of efficiency in sanitation, decided to entrust the sanitation work where there is a need in Municipalities / Municipal Corporations to this societies formed with the retired public Health workers or their dependents and Badili workers with the following modalities.

1. The societies should be registered under societies Registration Act.

2. The Members should belong to retired Public Health workers their children / and other Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe community people having experience of sanitation work such as Badili workers.

3. The Municipalities should prepare estimates, which should includes and estimated requirement of man power for sweeping drain cleaning and Garbage collection apart from supervision and cost of hiring a vehicle, bringing the conservancy articles and disinfectant etc., The number of trips and the distance involved. The designated place of dumping of garbage should also be worked on. The usual procedure of inviting tenders as or tender rules should as followed. A model treatment is shown as Annexure. I.

4. The society should participate in the tenders called for by the Municipalities. Municipal Corporations and willing to take up the work at lowest tender rates.

5. A model estimates is shown as Annexure. II. The rates to be adopted should not exceed those existed in 1995-96. The recommended maximum rates for the subsequent years will be as fixed by the Special Commissioner and Director of Municipal Administration for time to time.

BII It is also considered that the fixation of rates for sweeping and drain cleaning, garbage collection, supervision and cost of hiring vehicles etc., depends on the local conditions and availability of men and material. The special Commissioner and Director of Municipal Administration will fix the maximum rates on the above works.

IV. The Special Commissioner and Director of Municipal / Administration and Commissioners of Municipal Corporation / Municipalities In the state are requested to take necessary action on the lines.

ANNEXURE. I

MODALITIES FOR FORMATION OF SOCIETIES BY THE RETIRED P.H WORKERS / THEIR CHILDREN / BADILI WORKERS.

1. The societies should be registered under societies registration act.
2. The Members should belong to retired P.H workers / their children / and other SC / ST community people having experience at sanitation work such as badili workers.
3. The Municipalities should prepare estimates, which should include the estimates requirement of man power for sweeping, drain cleaning and garbage collection apart from Supervision and cost of hiring a vehicle, bringing the conservancy articles and disinfectants etc., the number of trips and the distance involved depending upon. The designated place of dumping of garbage should also be worked out. The usual procedure of inviting tenders as per tender rules should be followed. A model agreement as shown as annexure. II.
4. The society should participate in the tenders called by the Municipality and willing to take up the work at the lowest tender rates.
5. A model estimates prepared by Municipal Corporation Kurnool is enclosed on Annexure. III. The rates to be adopted should not exceed these at least in 1995 – 96. The recommended maximum rates for the subsequent year will be given by the Govt. from time to time.
