1. Sealed tenders will be received in the prescribed form by the Head of Parks (Horticulture) G.V.M.C. upto 4.00 P.M. on 03-3-2009 in the office of the Head of Parks (Horticulture), G.V.M.C. Situated in Swarna Bharathi Indoor Stadium and will be opened at 4.30 P.M. on the same day in the presence of tender or their authorized agents. If the last date of receipt of tenders happened to be a holiday, the tenders will be received and opened on the next working day.
2. The Commissioner of the Greater Visakhapatnam Municipal Corporation, is the authority to accept the tender and reserves the right to accept or reject any one all the tenders partially or completely without assigning any reasons thereof.
3. The cost of tender schedules should be remitted in the Saukaryam, Greater Visakhapatnam Municipal Corporation in favour of the Commissioner, Greater Visakhapatnam Municipal Corporation, Visakhapatnam and it should not be refunded at any circumstances.
4. Last date for receipt of application for the supply of tender schedules through the tender box is on 2-3-2009 up to 4.00 P.M. at office of the Parks, L&C.(Horticulture), Swarna Bharathi Indoor Stadium. If the last date of application happened to be holiday, the applications will be received on the next working day and shall be treated as having been received in time. The contractors are requested to enclose proof of the attested copy of the required class of registration for verification without fall with applications.
5. The E.M.D. amount by way of demand draft 1% of the estimate contract value drawn after the date of issue of tender notice in favour of the Commissioner, Greater Visakhapatnam Municipal Corporation, Visakhapatnam should be enclosed along with tender schedule application. The successful tender should pay the balance amount E.M.D. at 1.5% of the estimate contract value at the time of agreement in the shape of D.D. or Bank Guarantee from any Nationalized Schedule Banks in favour of the Commissioner, Grater Visakhapatnam Municipal Corporation, Visakhapatnam. The Application for tender schedule without the cost of tender schedule and 1% of E.M.D. will be rejected.
6. After buying a tender schedule, if the contractor does not tender for the work his E.M.D. will be forfeited (Cash or Bank Guarantee or both)
7. Tender schedule will be issued from 25-2-2009 to 02-3-2009 up to 4.00 P.M. on production of proof tender schedule cost and 1% of estimate contract value towards E.M.D. and relevant experience certificate.
8. The contractors are requested to note the postal address on the tender schedule regarding any correspondence by the department.
9. Tender documents will not be sent by post. The contractor is allowed to submit the tender either personally or through his agent or by post. In case of submission of tender by post, the risk and responsibility for either loss or delays in transit is to be borne by the contractor.
10. Tender schedules are not transferable.
11. (a) The tenderer who withdraws his offer within the validity period mentioning in the schedule will forgo his E.M.D.  
(b) The tender validity period is 90 days from the date of receipt of tender.  
(c) The class of contractors / firm mentioned as per G.O.Ms.No.521, MA&UD Department dt.10-12-1984 and G.O.Ms.No.23, I&CAD Department dt.05-03-1999 and G.O.Ms.No.94, I&CAD (PW-COD) Department dt.01-07-2003 are only eligible to participate in the tenders.
12. Conditional tenders will not be accepted.
13. The successful tenderer should pay the Additional Security Deposit (A.S.D), if he/she/firm quoted their tender which are less by more than 25% of the estimated rates a Bank Guarantee or Demand Draft for the difference between the tendered amount and 75% of the estimated contract value as per the amendment issued for tender procedures vide G.O.M S.No. 17, I&CAD (PW-COD) Department dt.06-02-2004.
14. The tenderers will not be required to quote item wise rates but to state clearly his willingness to execute the work at the percentage excess or less or on par over the estimated value indicated at of schedule-A.

- 15 If the Executive Authority requires the original document the contractor / firm shall furnish the same at any time. If the contractor / firm fails to furnish the same, the application / tender will be summarily rejected.
- 16 The E.M.D. in the shape of Banker Guarantee will not be made applicable for the works costing of Rs.50.00 lakhs (ECV) and below. For above works single cover system shall be followed and the E.M.D. can be submitted by way of Demand Draft as per the G.O.Ms.No.142/I&CAD (PW-Reforms) Department dt.20-12-2004.
- 17 As per G.O.Ms.No.159/TR&B (R-III) Department dt.30-10-2004 that the present 0.25% contribution recovered in the contractor bills regarding NAC continue and may be divided between Chief Ministers Relief Fund and NAC in the ratio of 0.15% and 0.10% respectively with effect from 01-11-2004.

2. The contractor / Agency / Firm should maintain a attendance registers at premises with particulars of name of the person, No of persons and specific purpose for which they are engaged etc., for ready reference to the officers for verification
3. They should maintain a stock register and record of receipt of stocks every month.
4. The persons engaged for garden work execution should attend the duties from 8am to 5.00pm
5. The work is to be done strictly in accordance with the specifications given in the schedule and as laid down as per instructions of the (Horticulture) in charge of the work from time to time.
6. The contractor is responsible for taking precautionary measures for the safety of the lives of the workers, working under in and the responsibility arising due to any mishap during the execution of work the payment of any compensation etc., lies entirely on the port of the contractor.
7. The rates quoted by the contractor should be inclusive of all labour and materials leads, and lifts in all situation etc, unless other wise specified and no claim on this will be entertained.
8. Any damages caused to the G.V.M.C. property either directly or indirectly shall be mace good by the contractor at his own cost.
9. No claim for the increase in rate of the material cost during the contract period will be entertained by the department
10. The department reserves the right to cancel the execution of some item or units of work at any time during the execution of work. No claim by the contractor on his contract and due to variation of any particular item will be entertained.
11. The contractor should submit daily report, his day's program of work in proforma in the early hours of every day.
12. During execution of work any damages caused by agency shall be made good by the contractor at his own cost.
13. A site order book is to be kept by the contractor at the site of work. Any orders and / or instructions issued by the departmental officers shall be entered in the book and shall be deemed to have been legally issued the contractor shall sign each entry in token up having the seen the same.
